Burbank – Wanted to follow-up with a previous conversation about encryption standards or a multi-year roll out plan. Ray Edey's response: the Technical Committee is working on that item. With the potential personnel changes on the horizon, the two key players developing it are Jim Floyd and Gordon Arnold. We have been working on re-inventing the team and they have made a lot of progress but they have not yet come to an agreement at the Committee level. The impairment at this time is the technical ability of some cells has exceeded that of others due to their technological advancements because they are using more state of the art equipment, so we need to take a step back and determine where everyone is going to be and what are we all capable of to determine a solution and then there will probably be a monetary issue as well. We need to tighten up the security on the encryption and accessibility to it and the ability to manage it, key management. One of the first things that need to be done is to determine how to fund the key management tool. The technology will catch up very quickly. The Technology Committee has this as a standing item.
